A choir for the future



SUPPORTING THE CHOIR

We invite all our Friends to consider how best they can support the choir and its work. Regular donations are most valuable in giving consistent and long-term backing for the choir's many activities. Here are ways in which individual Friends can make a real difference by enabling the choir to realize its full potential. Academical clerk	£600 per year	Singing in the choir runs parallel to students' academic courses, in a variety of different subjects.
Organ scholar	£750 per year	Organ scholars assist the Organist with every aspect of training the choir, and gain invaluable experience as performers alongside their academic studies.
Singing lessons	£750 per year per clerk	The choir supports individual clerks' vocal development with free singing lessons from its acclaimed singing teacher Bronwen Mills.
Tours	£2,500 funds the choir's concert fee	The choir's reputation has been built over the 100 or more tours round the world – an unrivalled professional and educational experience for all singers who take New College beyond the college walls.
Concert	£4,000 pays for a small instrumental ensemble	The choir relishes the opportunity for live performance, and has established a reputation for stylish interpretations with some of the world's leading period instrument ensembles, such as The English Concert.
Recording	£18,000 funds a recording with choir and organ.	The choir's discography runs to an impressive 150 discs, spanning many different periods and genres – fulfilling an important role in academic research as well as performance.
