Welcome to New College Chapel, where worship has been offered since the late fourteenth century. We hope you will find peace and space for reflection in this beautiful building, built to the glory of God and designed to resound with music and words of praise.

The choristers and clerks sing together on Sundays, Tuesdays, Fridays and Saturdays, except in half term; the Clerks sing Evensong on Mondays, and the Choristers a form of Vespers (the Benedictine evening office) most Thursdays. On alternate Tuesdays there is a short service of Compline at 9.00 pm. There are Eucharists on alternate Saturdays.

Our customary termly 'Cantata Vespers' takes place on Sunday of Second Week, 30 April. This term we present Bach's *Wir müssen durch viel Trübsal in das Reich Gottes eingehen*, composed in either 1726 or 1728, using material from his Concerto for Harpsichord in the first two movements. The preacher at this service is the distinguished scholar and performer Professor John Butt.

We welcome our colleagues from the other Oxford choral foundations to sing Evensong with us on Tuesday of Third Week, 9 May; there will be a concert by the same forces at the cathedral on Thursday 6 July, featuring the 40-part motet *Spem in alium* by Thomas Tallis.

Music by living composers appears throughout the term, including the recently commissioned New College Service by Deborah Pritchard, two recent works by Cheryl Frances-Hoad and the first performances of anthems by Nico Muhly and Daniel Gilchrist. We also sing a motet by former Academical Clerk, the late Alistair Putt, on 12 May.

The Organist is always happy to hear from anyone considering a choristership for their son (auditions take place in January of the candidate's school Year 2), or an Academical Clerkship (undergraduate choral scholarship) at any time.
