Our customary termly ‘Cantata Vespers’ takes place on Sunday of Seventh Week, 2 June. This term we present Bach’s *Brich dem Hungrigen dein Brot* (BWV 39), first heard in Leipzig on the First Sunday Trinity, 23 June 1726. Other services are furnished with music from the sixteenth century to the present day, including recent works by Piers Connor Kennedy, Cecilia MacDowall, Matthew Martin, Joanna Marsh, Kim Porter and Deborah Pritchard, and new pieces by the college’s own organists.
