Our customary termly ‘Cantata Vespers’ takes place on Sunday of Week 7, 24 November. This term we present perhaps the best-known of all Bach’s church cantatas: *Wachet auf, ruft uns die Stimme*, BWV 140). Not originally the Advent work it is often assumed to be, *Wachet auf* was composed in 1731 – very late in relation to other extant cantatas – for the 27th Sunday after Trinity, the final Sunday before Advent that year. This term we also give the first public performances of new works by James Burton and Andrew Gant, and perform much other music by living composers, including Cheryl Frances-Hoad, David Hurd, Joanna Marsh, Matthew Martin, Dónal McCann, Thea Musgrave, Deborah Pritchard and Roxanna Panufnik.

The Organist is always happy to hear from anyone considering a choristership for their son.
