Trinity Term 2022

W elcome to New College Chapel, where worship has been offered since the late fourteenth century. We hope you will find peace and space for reflection in this beautiful building, built to the glory of God and designed to resound with music and words of praise.

The choristers and clerks sing together on Sundays, Tuesdays, Fridays and Saturdays, except in half term; the Clerks sing Evensong on Mondays, and the Choristers a form of Vespers (the Benedictine evening office) most Thursdays. On alternate Tuesdays there is a short service of Compline at 9.00 pm. There are Eucharists on some Saturdays, on Sunday of Sixth Week (with Confirmations), and on the two solemn feasts that fall on Thursdays: Ascension and Corpus Christi.

Our customary service of Vespers with a Cantata takes place this term on Sunday of Second Week, 1 May, featuring Bach's serene setting of a paraphrase of Psalm 23, *Der Herr ist mein getreuer Hirt*, composed for the Third Sunday of Easter (known as *Misericordias Domini*) in 1731.

Music by living composers appears throughout the term, and includes recent commissions for New College Choir by Caitlin Harrison, Joanna Marsh and Deborah Pritchard.

There are weekly organ recitals on Thursdays, beginning in Second Week. On Saturday 11 June after Evensong we launch a new recording of the organ by Assistant Organist Dónal McCann: a programme of sparkling instrumental concerti by Albinoni, Vivaldi and others, transcribed for the organ in the 1710s by J. S. Bach and his cousin J. G. Walther.

Our annual Chorister Open Day takes place on Saturday 11 June, ending with a shortened service of Evensong. As always, the Organist is happy to hear from anyone considering a choristership for their son, or an Academical Clerkship (undergraduate choral scholarship) at any time.
